Griffin House, Hammersmith - Burj ST cubicles

London based Aros Design architects specified the Decra Burj ST cubicle system for this office refurbishment close to Hammersmith town centre.

The ST modification allows the well known Burj flush fascia to be wed to existing stud or block partitions - erected in this case by the main contractor to allow for integral washbasins and hand driers.

38mm lightweight doors and pilasters are clad in oak effect laminate with solid oak rebated edges. High quality German designed, DDA compliant locks are standard Burj issue with matching stainless steel furniture throughout.

A half height duct in matching laminate encases the cistern to complete this impressive installation.

Whether you choose the ST version or whether you opt for the standard cubicle with conventional laminate faced partitions, Burj offers a real money-saving alternative to traditional 44mm joinery without compromising design.
