Offices 9-15 Sackville Street, London

JM Architects specified the Decra **Burj** cubicle system for this prestigious office refurbishment in Sackville Street near Piccadilly Circus.

44mm doors and pilasters with rebated hardwood edge, are clad in American Walnut veneer and partitions are 30mm thick particleboard faced with high - pressure laminate. Rear duct composite panels are in a contrast blue plain colour laminate. Quality DDA compliant stainless steel hardware.

Vanity units are constructed from Italian stone with glass faced under cupboard doors. Urinal panels are made from durable and water resistant solid grade laminate with Geberit glass modesty panels.

This hybrid version of Decra's popular Burj system incorporates flush fitting floor interface in aluminium with the design extending to the outside of the cubicle doors - acting as a kick plate along with the base of the urinal panels.
