William Morris Gallery - Walthamstow Decra **Burj** - Loo-ART

The William Morris Gallery is the only public gallery devoted to the hugely prolific Victorian designer, craftsman and social campaigner, William Morris. It is home to an internationally significant collection illustrating his life, art, public achievement and continuing influence.

As part of a major refurbishment of the gallery, Decra worked closely with Vinci Construction to display samples of Morris's artwork as melamine protected digital images.

These adorn the cubicle door facings and rear duct panels in a variety of colours and patterns to create a visually stunning installation.

The flush-fascia cubicles are from the Decra **Burj** range with 38mm lightweight doors faced with Loo-Art laminate fronts and plain colour laminate on the reverse. High quality DDA compliant stainless steel locks, coat hooks and hinges are standard with **Burj** which has proved a popular alternative to 44mm joinery.

The digitally imaged rear duct panels are supplied in durable 12mm solid grade (compact) laminate. For more details contact the Decra sales department.

Focus on Heritage case study 1

Specification:

Cubicle doors/pilasters
38mm lightweight core faced with digital images for the door fascia's - plain colour laminate door reverse. Ash hardwood rebated edges.

Partitions:
Hpl laminate faced particleboard - 19mm overall.

Rear Duct panels:
12mm solid grade laminate with digital image on front faces.
