Lady Eleanor Holles School, Hampton - Decra Burj Gloss cubicles

Architects Walters and Cohen specified Decra's Burj flush fascia cubicle system for a new Arts and Music building at the prestigious Lady Eleanor Holles School situated in Hampton, Middlesex.

This version of Burj has 38mm lightweight core doors and pilasters faced with white gloss high pressure laminate. The rebated hardwood edges have been painted to match the gloss black hpl faced internal partitions and duct panels. Being a true full height cubicle, Burj uses extruded aluminium interfaces at both floor and ceiling junctions which, in turn, allow the use of matching laminate infill strips to conceal all fixings.

High quality, German designed, DDA compliant stainless steel locks, s/s buffered coat hooks and sprung s/s hinges are used to compliment the high level of specification offered by Burj to its users and specifiers alike.

Decra's solid surfacing division also made the Corian Slabb vanity units with matching laminate faced under panels.

Decra are **chain of custody** accredited and can provide a fully PEFC compliant specification for all Burj cubicle systems.

Doors/pilasters - 38mm lightweight core faced with gloss finish Hpl. Hardwood edges rebated & painted to match partition colour.

Partitions & Ducts - 19mm gloss laminate faced particleboard.

Vanity units:
Decra Slabb - Corian Glacier White with matching white gloss laminate faced under panels
