Docklands Bowling Complex Chicane cubicles, Reflex lockers

Architects Barr Gazetas specified Decra's flush fascia Chicane cubicle system and Reflex changing room lockers for this prestigious new bowling venue in London's docklands.

Chicane's 38mm lightweight core fronts are clad here with high pressure laminate in a high gloss finish. The rebated Ash hardwood edges of the doors and pilasters have been stained to blend with the black fascia. High quality, German designed DDA compliant locks, sprung hinges and coat-hooks are all in stainless steel as are the pull handles for the ambulant disabled cubicles. 19mm gloss laminate faced partitions sit on 20mm s/steel pedestal feet.

The Reflex lockers have high gloss laminate faced doors and new Assa digital code locks as an alternative to the traditional coin return/retain mechanisms.

The high gloss finish of the cubicles and lockers complements and reflects the monochrome theme of these stylish washrooms and combines beautifully with the embossed metal ceiling tiles to complete these high quality washrooms.

Doors and pilasters: 38mm core faced in high gloss Hpl. Rebated Ash hardwood edges stained black.

Partitions: 19mm gloss Hpl faced particleboard.

Ironmongery: DDA compliant lock, sprung hinges, buffered coat hooks, 20mm pedestal feet - all in stainless steel.

Reflex Lockers:

Doors: 19mm high gloss Hpl on particle board
 Carcass: White MFC.
 Ironmongery: Assa Digital code locks.
