Ravensfield House, Middlesex University-Freestyle wc/shower cubicles

Putney based architects BPR specified Decra **Freestyle** w/c and shower cubicles for Ravensfield House as part of a major refurbishment of Middlesex University's Hendon Campus.

All panels are made from durable 12mm solid grade laminate. The contrast between the Lime Green and Wenge wood effect laminates easily achieves DDA compliance as does the satin anodised cubicle ironmongery including the pilaster mounted lock and indicator.

Solid grade (compact) laminate is ideal for both toilet and shower areas as it is impervious to moisture. Moreover, it has high impact resistance which contributes to an extended life - even in heavy duty use!

Freestyle is available at many heights - including a virtual full height option in its Decra **Altus** guise - and this, together with its high performance and low cost per cubicle, makes it ideal for schools and colleges looking to upgrade their washrooms while having to do so within increasingly tight budget constraints.

Meeting **BREEM** specifications is not a problem either as Decra are fully chain of custody certified for sustainable timber.
