Queen Mary University Humanities building

Architect Wilkinson Eyre specified the Decra **Stratum** washroom cubicle system for a new building at the Queen Mary University Campus in Mile End.

Stratum is a linear fronted cubicle system that incorporates durable 20mm solid grade laminate for the doors and pilasters with a rebate applied to provide the flush frontage. Partitions and rear duct duct panels are manufactured from 13mm solid grade laminate.

Quality DDA compliant stainless steel hardware is used as standard on **Stratum** and the architect has created some vibrancy by using bright colours for the rear duct and urinal panels with plain grey for the doors and partitions.

Decra have already supplied the Stratum product for the main Queens Building at QMU in glossy laminate and digital photographic image combinations.

Stratum forms part of the Architectura collection of innovative washroom cubicles.
