



Queen Mary University - Queens Building with toilets designed by Decra ...

Decra were approached by Essex surveyors Cooch and Associates to design a solution for Queen Mary University Queens building in London's Mile End Road. Having seen our Loo-ART concept which uses digital imagery for aspects of cubicle panels, QMU estates department were keen to incorporate local scenes . Decra took a series of high - res images based around the Regents Canal and 3 were chosen for use on the cistern duct panels . The digital images are melamine encapsulated to form a Formica type which can be cleaned like normal high pressure laminate. Decra's Stratum range cubicles features 20mm solid grade laminate with a rebate applied to the long edges of the doors and pilasters to create a linear frontage. Glossy finish has been used to provide an extra lift to the scheme and a new" wave effect" solid grade laminate in a lustre white has been used for wall panelling. Other washroom zones will feature the other 2 digital images as well as some different gloss colour solid grade laminates. Vanity units are manufactured from the Durat range of solid surface materials that are 100% recyclable. Decra's latest venture in "total" design has been well received by the university and staff with comments that the washrooms are of a "hotel standard" Contact Decra for more details....
