The Tower of London - new visitor toilets

Decra worked closely with Historic Royal Palaces to create these stunning new washrooms using Decra's **Loo-ART** panel system combined with **Streamline** aluminium pilasters to create a contemporary combined cubicle solution for the Tower of London.

Cubicle doors are in white solid grade laminate and fall open when not in use which maximised the limited space within the washrooms as well as providing a quick visual aid with regards to any vacant cubicles. In a volume use area such as one of London's most significant visitor attractions we felt that this was an important part of the specification.

Rear duct panels have a series of graphic images conceived by the surveyors at Historic Royal Palaces encapsulated with melamine for longevity, with the imagery being relevant to the Tower and its environs.

Vanity units are constructed from Corian in a speckled white colour with semi recessed basins to again maximise the limited space.
